
<u>Mayors, Which Healthy Town Designation will</u> <u>your Town Earn This Year?</u>

Meet the 2024 Mental Health Initiative Grant Recipients: Learn About Their Upcoming Initiatives This year, 11 New Jersey towns have been awarded \$127,500 in grants through the Mayors Wellness Campaign to promote mental health, reduce stigma, prevent intimate partner violence, and address substance use. These grants, made possible by Walmart, will fund impactful projects such as mental health training, support groups, and community education program, many focusing on underserved populations to reduce health disparities.
